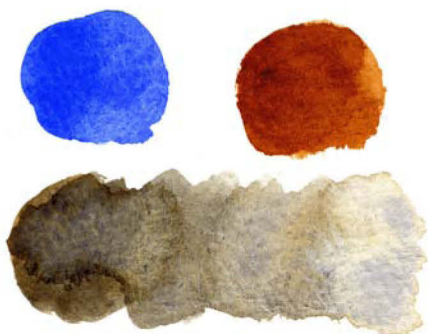


## Know Your Grays and Neutrals - Warm and Cool

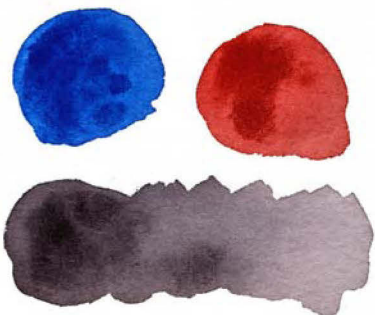
Almost any combination of two deep, dark colors, (one warm, the other cool) will produce a dark, interesting color. Try Ultramarine and Burnt Umber,



Prussian Blue and Raw Umber,



Dark blues with earth red-browns gives you a blue-black by mixing Phthalo or Thalo Blue and Cadmium Red Medium.



Black can lean towards any side of the color spectrum depending on the balance of colors in your mixture. To get a rich strong black try mixing equal parts of Alizarin Crimson with Thalo Green,



Burnt Sienna and Thalo Blue.
